Through the years, Coulee Council has expanded services to deal with all aspects of addiction, including prevention, intervention, crisis management, and recovery support. Because of dedicated volunteers and generous community support, these services continue to thrive.

Coulee Council offers a variety of services for the community, including prevention and drug presentations, intervention resources, a Drop-In Center, assessments, and a resource library.

Our Services

EDUCATION AND PREVENTION:

- Studies from the Centers for Substance Abuse Prevention (CSAP) have shown that early and consistent prevention programs help reduce alcohol and drug use and abuse.
- We provide free prevention programs to community organizations and educational facilities.

INFORMATION AND REFERRAL:

- We have Certified Alcohol and Drug Counselors who provide immediate, accurate confidential information regarding substance abuse and other addictions.
- We house the region's largest chemical abuse and recovery library.

COUNSELING:

- We provide crisis management assessments and referrals for those with addictions as well as their family and friends.
- Coulee Council also does underage assessments

RECOVERY SUPPORT:

- We provide programming for those with addictions and their family and friends
- The lower level of our office houses a Community Resource Center which provides a chemical-free environment for recovering people, their families and friends.
- We also offer on-site, consumer run support groups

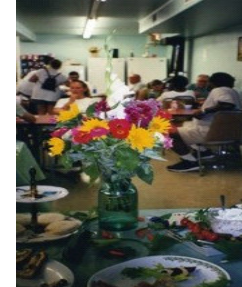
OUTPATIENT:
