What is the Thomas Noelke Resource Center?

The Thomas E. Noelke Recovery Center provides social and educational activities for recovering individuals and their friends and family. Volunteers work to keep the center open seven days a week, during regular business hours. The center provides late night information and referral, fun activities in a supportive environment and coffee brewing during all open hours.

The center also sponsors special recreational events, such as dances and picnics. The Recovery Discovery Discussion Group (RDDG) is a relapse prevention program that meets every Saturday morning where a speaker will present on different topics related to recovery.
